DSI Mobility Workshop

Switzerland

Workshop overview

Scope: Are you interested in research about the future of mobility? Do you want to connect and establish a research collaboration in this area? The DSI Mobility Community organizes the workshop as a 'marketplace of ideas' to support research exchange and collaborations in the area of mobility and digitalization. The topic themes include but are not limited to human mobility, navigation, autonomous vehicles, smart cities, drones, space mobility, etc.

Objectives: This workshop pursues three aims. First, to provide a platform for researchers from different disciplines to connect and present/exchange research ideas in this domain. Second, to develop a preliminary research plan for the ideas accepted for presentation within the focus group discussions. And third, to introduce potential funding opportunities for collaborations.

Programme

Day 1: We will start with a networking dinner on the evening of the arrival day.

Day 2: The workshop will include two sessions. In the morning session, participants will pitch their research ideas. In the afternoon session, the focus group discussion will be formed to develop a draft research plan for the ideas accepted for presentation. Also, potential funding opportunities will be introduced. The workshop will end with a wrap-up session to compile a list of ideas and challenges for initiating future research collaborations in the area of mobility and digitalization.

Participants

- Researchers of any discipline and seniority.
- PhD students may receive 1 ECTS point for participation.
- All presenters are expected to attend in person. Suitable adjustments will be made if needed, depending on the Covid-19 situation.

- The registration fee is 300 CHF and includes accommodation, coffee breaks, meals, and all materials used during the workshop. The travel costs are not included.
- We provide a limited number of travel grants for junior researchers; more information will be provided upon acceptance.
